Creating a Custom Dropbox App

In this article, we explain how you can create your own custom Dropbox App for use with the Dropbox Add-on. Create an app Visit the Dropbox App Console. Click the Create app button. For the Choose an API section select Dropbox API. For the Choose the type of access you need section select Full Dropbox. Enter a name for your custom app. If you have a personal and a business account which are linked you will be asked to select which account you want to own the app.
